Dear Parent/Guardian:

Delran High School, in partnership with Rowan College at Burlington County (RCBC), offers students taking select courses an opportunity to earn both high school and college credit. Your child is taking one or more of the courses that qualify. Attached is a list of the dual credit courses that are approved by RCBC's College Accelerated Program (CAP).

These courses are taught during the regular school day by members of the Delran High School staff who have been certified as RCBC adjunct professors. Students who would like to receive college credits will be required to complete the RCBC registration process and pay the RCBC tuition. CAP fees for the 2020-21 school year are as follows:

| | 3-4 credits | 5-8 credits | 9+ credits |

| Regular Rate | \$150 | \$300 | \$450 |
| Free/Reduced Lunch Rate | \$100 | \$200 | \$300 |

Please note that the student must earn a "C" (70-79) or better in order to be granted college credits.

RCBC has rolled out an online registration program. First-time students are requested to create an account. Instructions are attached. Students can register by computer or right on their smart phone by entering <https://rcbc.app.dualenroll.com> and providing some basic information. The information will carry over to their college application so please be accurate. Students who took CAP courses last year and paid tuition to RCBC will follow the instructions for returning students. The attachment to this letter can be used to help students navigate both processes.

AP students will still be able to take the AP test in the spring and they are encouraged to do so. CAP is not intended to replace the AP program, but offers another option for students to earn college credits.

Delran High School and RCBC strongly recommend that you research the policies of any college or university you are considering to determine their position regarding CAP credits. Once the payment and application have been sent to RCBC, there will be **no refunds** if a college/university does not accept CAP credits.

Students must request a transcript through Rowan College at Burlington County, upon successful completion of the CAP class. Transcripts will be sent a week or so after the request is made and they are free of charge.

The registration/payment deadline is November 2nd. If you think you will have trouble meeting this deadline, please notify Ms. Grady in the Guidance Office as soon as possible.

Please take the time to discuss this opportunity with your child. If you have any questions, please contact the Guidance department.
