All awards for underclassmen will be distributed next week when books and materials are returned. For members of the Class of 2020, you will receive your awards on Monday, June 15th when you receive your graduation materials. I wish to congratulate all of the awardees for their dedication to DHS and the Delran community!

Books and Materials Return/Pick-Up

Beginning **Monday, June 8th**, we will have books and materials returned to DHS. You should have received a letter last week that listed everything that we expect to collect. If you have any questions about any of the items listed, please reach out to your child's teacher for an explanation. We have set up this procedure to ensure the safety of both you and the DHS personnel. I ask that you please be patient with us as we wish to be sure that all materials that you return are accounted for. The process will go as follows:

- You **must** wear a mask when interacting with any school personnel.
- If you have a temperature of above 100.4 degrees, we ask that you do not come to the drop-off site and instead, have someone else drive your child.
- You must arrive during your designated time frame. [HERE](#) is the schedule.
- You may enter from either the Hartford Road or Conrow Road entrance.
- Once at the main parking lot, you will merge into one(1) lane and proceed to the temporary stop sign where you will be instructed to state your child's name and grade.
- You will be assigned a specific lane to then drive to (We have three(3) lanes set up to ensure the process moves quickly.).
- Once you arrive at the tent, you will be asked to exit your car and place any books or materials onto the table and retrieve any awards that have been earned and/or summer assignments that you will need.

- After your books have been checked-in, you will then proceed to the end of the parking lot where you will turn left to exit.
- All vehicles will exit onto Conrow Road.

If for some reason you know that you will be unable to make your scheduled time, please email Dr. Danielle Jones, Assistant Principal, at djones@delranschools.org so that alternate arrangements can be made.

Scholastic Expectations

During the **week of June 8th**, you and your child should expect exactly two graded assignments per week from each subject area. All assignments will be strictly computer-based, so that the return of books and materials should have no impact on any child.

During the **week of June 15th**, each student will be expected to complete one assignment from each subject area.

The last day to make-up any assignment(s) will be **Wednesday, June 17th**. After that date, no work will be accepted. For members of the Class of 2020, the last day for work to be turned-in will be **Monday, June 15th**.

Students who have not been engaged in their classes will earn that grade for the 4th Marking Period. In addition, students who have disengaged from the learning process will not earn credit for the course, regardless of their final grade as it will be determined that the student was absent from school for more than 12 days.

Final Grades will be posted on **Tuesday, June 23rd** on the Parent Portal.

Due to the remote learning situation that we have all been placed in and the lack of being able to truly assess students on learning standards, the decision has been made to forgo an Honor Roll or Principal's List for the 4th Marking Period.
