### **Further Education for the 2023 Graduates**

- 80% of our graduating seniors have continued their education at a 4-year college or university, 2-year college, or trade school.
- 51% of our graduating seniors have enrolled in a 4-year institution.
- 24% of our graduating seniors have enrolled in a 2-year college.
- 5% of our graduating seniors have enrolled in a technical/vocational school.
- 20% of our graduating seniors have pursued employment or enlistment in the military.

## **Honors/College Prep courses**

Delran High School offers a full array of honors and college preparatory courses for students interested in entering 4-year and 2-year colleges. These courses provide students with the skills and information they need to succeed in even the most demanding college and university programs. Honors and college preparatory courses are offered in Art, English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Technology, and World Languages.

All elective courses are taught at the college preparatory level.

## **Graduation Requirements**

To graduate from Delran High School, students must have earned 130 overall credits including 20 credits in English, 15 credits in Math, 15 credits in Science, 5 credits in World History or World Cultures, 10 credits in United States History, 5 credits of a World Language, 20 credits in Physical Education, 5 credits in Fine, Performing or Practical Arts, 2.5 credits in Financial Literacy and 5 credits in 21st Century Life and Careers or Career Tech Ed. Requirements for graduation also include satisfying the state proficiency testing requirements which include the NJSLA, SAT, ACT, PSAT, Accuplacer, ASVAB-AFQT, or Portfolio Appeal.

Community service requirement of 15 hours is required for all juniors. Five service hours are required for freshmen.

## **Grading System**

In July of 2004, the Delran Board of Education adopted a new grading system with passing grades ranging from 60-100. A Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated for DHS students based on a system with each course identified as general, college preparatory, honors, or Advanced Placement level. Each numerical grade carries a specific weight within those course levels.
